



## SUPER KART THAILAND

Dear racer/team,

Race 5 September 5, 2008

Please follow the requirement below:

1. In the last heat after the race, all racers must have a weight check at the scrutineer. After it is done, racer position 1,2, and 3 must have an engine check. It will be done by your own mechanic that will open up the engine on a container. When the mechanic is done, you may bring your kart back. You don't have to wait for the engine for the officials will check it. After the official is done checking, you will receive you engine back. Mechanic must be ready to open up the engine within 15 minutes after the weight check, if not the racer will be disqualified.(Please provide your own container)
2. Please feel free to ask in the racer briefing(Saturday 5.30 or Sunday 9.00) if you have any concern or question. You are free to ask the clerk of course or officials at any time.
3. Racer can use spare engine without leaving it with the scrutineer. You must have a request paper and buy an engine seal(200B) at registration office instead. Please fill in your name/kart number/class in the request paper and have the clerk of course sign. You must leave the first engine at the scrutineer to have a check before taking it back.
4. CADET CLASS B will be doing a rolling start unlike last race.
5. We are honored to have Mr. Itthipol Khunpluem in our opening ceremony. Racers please be in complete uniform and line up in front of the control tower. We will be live on TV at 3pm.
6. In this race, we have a special trophy for racer that have the fastest time record in time trial, heat1, heat2, or heat3 in each class. The trophy will be given out in the evening.
